Japan's Rules of the Road

Everyone can make this "a safe place for cycling"

Kagawa Prefecture is promoting safe cycling through the establishment of rules for safe bicycle use. Let's share the roads with cars, pedestrians, and other bicycles with mutual respect and understanding.

- In principle, bicycles should ride on the roads, and on sidewalks only when necessary.
- Ride on the left side of the road.
- Yield to pedestrians on sidewalks, veering towards the road.
- Follow all safety rules.

5 Helmet Use

Helmets can save your life.

The fatality rate for head trauma reduced to **1/4**

2.3% Without Helmets
0.57% With Helmets

Other prohibited behaviors

- Riding with open umbrella
- Riding while using headphones
- Riding while using a mobile phone

Please get bicycle insurance!

- The number of cases involving high liability sums for traffic accidents is increasing.
- Just in case, get bicycle insurance that covers accident liability.

Cycling Safety Information

Don't forget to do a check before you ride!

- Tires** Is there enough air? Any tears, holes, or deformities?
- Brakes** Check if they work and how strong they are.
- Is your light bright enough?**
- Bell: Do you have one and does it work?**
- Check each part** Anything loose or too tight?
- Chain** Is it dirty? Is there proper lubrication?
- Position** After checking your bike's condition, check its position.

Bike bag

If you use a bus or taxi on the island, you'll need to put your bike in a bike bag.

Things to Have Check before you ride!

- Hex key (Allen/Unbrako/zeta key)** The bike seat and most bike parts use a 4-6 mm hex key.
- Tire puncture repair kit**
- Portable air pump**
- Bike key**
- Bike bag**
- Normal footwear (including sandals)** When on the ferry or other public transportation, or when visiting sights, please change out of your cycling shoes.

About AEDs

AEDs will guide user with sound and pictures, so follow the directions to operate. They are safe and simple to use.

- Follow the guide to operate.
- Turn on the power (some models will turn on when you open the cover)
- Attach the electric shock pads
- If the machine says a shock is necessary, the electric shock will commence.

Be considerate towards pedestrians and local residents

The roads are not a race track. "Cycling Around Shodoshima" rides through local residents' neighborhoods, so show your courtesy and slow down when traveling through villages and hamlets.

Be careful of sharp curves and accidents!

On Shodoshima, there are many sharp curves and narrow roads, especially along the peninsulas.

To prevent head-on collisions, please reduce your speed when visibility is poor or along curves with blue lines painted on the roadside.

Gift of The Sun A-3

Standing at the entrance to the island of olives, this sculpture looks like a giant olive leaf wreath.

This huge sculpture sits where the lighthouse used to be. Perched atop a brilliant sphere, a dragon silently roars.

Recommended photo spots

Togata Community Center A-3

Former primary school on the west end of the island. Movies and videos have been shot here. Every spring, you can see carp banners swimming in the sky.

Dofuchi Strait B-3

At 9.93 meters, it's the Guinness World Record holder for the world's narrowest strait. You can get a certificate for crossing it at the Tonosho Town Hall.

Fukuda Coast F-1
 (Sanuki Top 100 Views)

See the everchanging coastal scenery unfold before you from atop the high observation area.

Superb views await you.

Places to Visit

Kankakei Gorge D-2

Enjoy the seasonal landscapes along this gorge, from the fresh green and flowers of spring, the rich green and birds' voices in summer, autumn foliage, and icy snow of winter.

Hitoyama Village Kabuki Stage C-2

A traditional Village Kabuki stage with a proud 300-year history. Nearby, check out the Nakayama Village Kabuki Stage, Nakayama Senmanda (terraced rice fields), and Komame Shokudo which continues to share the island's heritage.

Shiohazashi Observatory C-2

At 777 meters, cyclists who climb the steep slope to the highest observation point in the Seto Inland Sea will be rewarded with an amazing panoramic view.

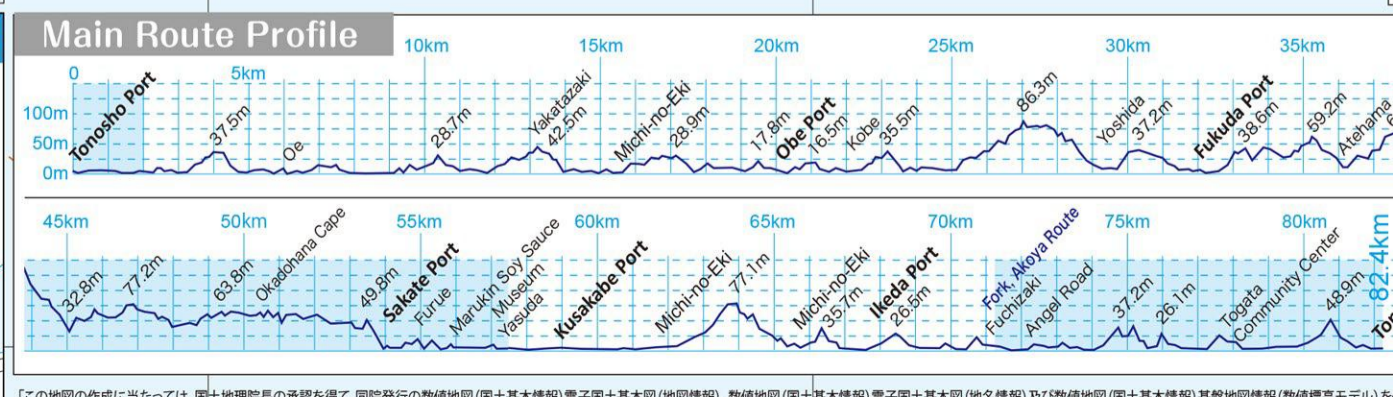

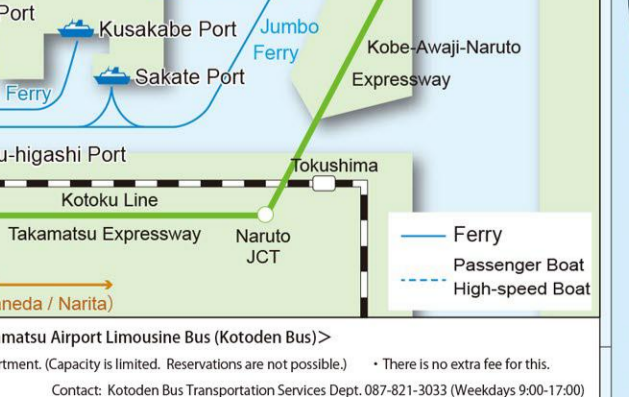

Gives you discounts on ferry fares!

(How to use it, Important reminders)

- Be sure to show your Cycruise PASS when you board.
- You only get the discount if you bring your bike on the boat when you pay. If your bike is stored in a bike bag, you will not get the discount.
- Method of payment will differ by ferry company, so be sure to check.
- Some ferries will have a limit of bicycles allowed on board.
- This pass is valid for three days after it is issued.
