Facility Introduction

Located on National Route 11, at the sight of a historic battle. There is a park here as well.

A stone monument made from the highest quality aji stone and a train that ran for 80 years are on display here. There is an observation desk, where you can look out over the Seto Inland Sea and watch the trains run along the coast.

Close to the fishing village of Aji, you can eat at the self-service style Jakoyo seafood diner. Prices are reasonable, and the noteworthy dishes include 'hamachi-no-zukedon' (flavored yellowtail on rice) and 'kakimeshi' (oysters on rice). The Tendon Gokenzan is piled high with tempura for a big impact.

At the local products corner you will find many of Shikoku's four prefectures' specialties. Common favorites are udon and soy beans, but don't miss the Japanese sake, udon goods, traditional handicrafts and works of art from local artists. Local people also like this place, as the newest original products from inside and around Kagawa are released first here.
