



Using taxis

How to take a taxi

1 Search

Get into a taxi at the airport or stations.

2 Get in

The driver will open the back door, so be careful.



4 Pay fare

Pay the amount shown on the meter.

* Payment only in Japanese Yen.

* Extra charge for early morning and late night fares, in some cases.

* Some taxis do not accept credit cards, confirm with driver in advance.



3 Tell destination

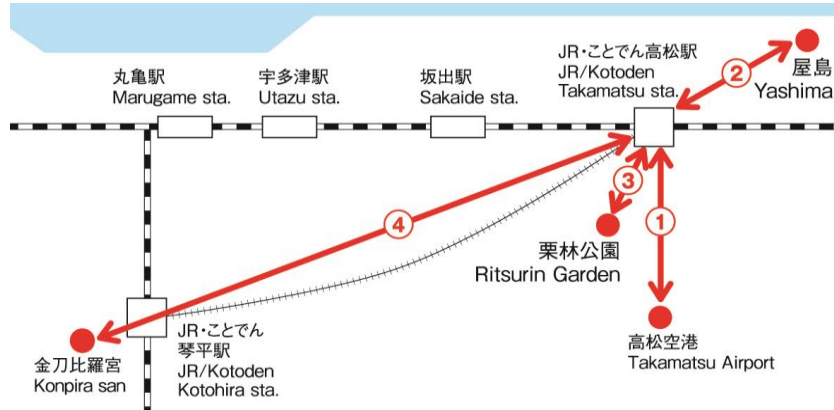
If you have a map, show it to the driver.

5 Get out

The driver will open the back door, so be careful.

Travel time and fare for main tourist destinations (Map is not to scale)

o Takamatsu / Kotohira area



1	Takamatsu Airport to Takamatsu Station Approx. 5,000JPY Approx. 30 minutes
2	Takamatsu Station to Yashima Summit Approx. 3,000 JPY Approx. 50 minutes
3	Takamatsu Station to Ritsurin Park Approx. 1,000 JPY Approx. 10 minutes
4	Takamatsu Station to Konpiragu Shrine Approx. 10,000 JPY Approx. 60 minutes

The above travel times and fares are just estimations.

o Shodoshima Area

There are piers at each port, but it is difficult to find taxis in other places so it is recommended to hire a taxi for the entire trip.
