## **Facility Introduction**

This Way Station has the market Seiryu-no-Sato, selling produce directly from the farm and the hotspring Epia Mikado. It is located on the border between Kagawa and Tokushima prefectures. Here you can enjoy the hotsprings once described by the local Kagawa artist, Hiraga Gennai. Also known as the Japanese Da Vinci, he wrote "spring water drips from the rockface in a deep forest, white like milk... the local people call this milk of the stone, and prize it highly..." Here you will find the Large Bath of the Source Spring, Jacuzzi Bath, Water Bath and Sauna. The baths are stocked with conditioning shampoo.

Products like locally made tofu and fried tofu, sushi, red rice and vegetables are popular not only with the local people but also among visitors as well. Soybean flower soft serve ice cream is another local specialty that is loved by everyone across all age groups.

On sale you will find wooden keyholders, chopstick holders and straps, all of which are very appropriate for Mannocho and its rich timber resources.
