Introduction

This multi-purpose commercial complex, a renovated street of warehouses, is located 10 minutes walk from Sun Port Takamatsu near the sea. This old neighborhood has existed for a long time, and this is evident from the old buildings that have been rusted by the ocean winds. Warehouses line the back streets, and the relaxed and free atmosphere makes it popular with the young generations.

Inside you will find a restaurant where you can enjoy the French flavors of an original cuisine, a cafe with popular French pastries and quiches, general shops selling unique products, a book cafe that communicates the allure of old items such as handicrafts, tools and books, and clothing stores selling imported childrens' clothes.


There is a pedestrian street in the vicinity, where you can wander around watching the islands in Seto Inland Sea and ships going in and out of the harbor.
